

Preparing an EDGE Presentation Plan (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable)

Presentation Preparation

- Assemble materials in advance of the presentation
- Identify the learning objectives you want the group to understand from your presentation

“Explain” component of the lesson

- Capture the attention of the learners. Create interest in the subject. Give them an interest to learn.
- Explain the concept being addressed in more than one way
- Use media (flip chart, white board, etc) to organize information. Show them the outline of the presentation.
- Interact with questions and answers with the learners

“Demonstration” component of the lesson

- Clearly demonstrate the skill
- Identify steps needed to complete the skill
- Note areas of difficulty in mastering the skill

“Guide” component of the lesson

- Assist the learners in applying the skill
- Provide feedback during the guiding process

“Enable” component of the lesson

- Have the learners apply the skill independently
- Presenter evaluates learners ability to apply the skill
