B. Junior Leadership Prerequisites

1. The Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, and all Patrol Leaders are required to have Junior Leadership Training prior to being elected to one of these positions.
2. The Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, and all Patrol Leaders are required to be First Class Rank or higher.
3. Instructors have earned the Troop 19 Woodsman Award and are certified to teach based upon the "Teaching Edge Principles" .

C. Patrol Leader Council (PLC) Meeting Attendance

1. Each leader that is a member of the Patrol Leader Council (PLC) is required to attend 75% of the monthly Patrol Leader Council (PLC) meetings to obtain credit for the position.
2. Any leader missing more than 75% of the PLC meetings will be removed from the leadership position.

D. Weekly Meeting and Campout Attendance

1. Leaders are expected to attend 80% of the weekly meetings and 70% of the troop activities and 100% of the required activities while at their current rank to complete the leadership requirement for the rank advancement.

E. Candidate Nomination and Acceptance Criteria

1. If a Scout desires to be nominated for a troop position he must submit a Leadership Application Form by the deadline requested.

F. Youth Leadership Report

1. Youth Leaders will submit the Youth Leadership Report on a monthly basis to receive credit for leadership advancement.
