Working as a Patrol I am...

1. Listening:

I listen to my patrols ideas and use their ideas to help get new ideas (piggy-backing).

2. Questioning:

I ask questions of my patrol to help them figure out what to do and to extend their thinking.

3. Persuading:

I exchange ideas, defend my ideas and try to explain my thinking to my patrol.

4. Respecting:

I respect the opinions in my patrol. I offer encouragement and support for new ideas and efforts.

5. Helping:

I help my patrol by offering my assistance.

6. Sharing:

I share with my patrol. I make sure I share my ideas and thinking. I share the jobs.

7. Participating:

I contribute to the patrol assignment. I am actively involved with the work.
